WHY OUR EMPHASIS ON EJRP

Youth that are significantly challenged by mental health issues must attain two key milestones in order to transition into independent young adult lives; a high school diploma and the ability to seek and retain a job.

Our EJRP cultivates communication skills, financial literacy, resilience, work ethic and the capacity to be part of a team.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Our EJRP incorporates the following elements:

1) Teach practical workplace skills - improving literacy, numeracy, financial literacy, computer skills, first aid and workplace safety

2) Communication skills - Resume writing, oral communications, and code of professional ethics

3) Job hunting and retention - The art of research and networking, interview skills, and seeking mentorship

4) Entrepreneurship - For selected students, a full high school credit shall be delivered for experiential learning in the art of starting a business

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
